## **Basic Function/Job Summary:**

The Finance Manager is the leader of the Financial Team and is responsible for administering the financial management system for Mills Manufacturing Corporation.

In addition to financial duties, the Finance Manager also directs and maintains all Computerized Information Systems for the company.

- Manage the accounting department and all aspects of accounts payable, accounts receivable, investments, cash flow and payroll
- Ensure compliance with local, state, and federal government reporting requirements and tax filings
- Issue timely monthly financial statements
- Manage all aspects of annual audits
- Provide financial analyses as needed, in particular for capital investments, pricing decisions, and contract negotiations
- Participate in the development of short and long range business plans, strategies, and projections
- Develop, implement and maintain cost system
- Responsible for all aspects of the company computer network and applications to ensure that technology remains effective and current
- Responsible for internal help desk for users of company computer network
- Manage commercial banking relationships
- Serve as a member of the administrative committee for employee benefits and interact with outside service providers as necessary
- Responsible for separate accounting for other companies with joint ownership
- Participate in strategic data analysis, research, and modeling for leadership team
- Develop trends and projections for Mills' finances
- Create financial models, analyses and business plans in support of business initiatives
- Ensure forecasting accuracy and predictability.
